Dear Resident:

Construction of Phase 1 of the Illinois Jobs Now Project is expected to begin the week of April 18, 2016. Streets that will be affected include 86<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 75<sup>th</sup> Street to 71<sup>st</sup> Street; 73<sup>rd</sup> Place from 88<sup>th</sup> Ave to 86<sup>th</sup> Ave; 85<sup>th</sup> Ave from 79<sup>th</sup> Street to I294 and 85<sup>th</sup> Court from 79<sup>th</sup> Street to I294. Construction operations will start along 85<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 85<sup>th</sup> Court with sanitary sewer point repairs. As sewer point repairs are completed the street construction crews will move into the area.

Improvements will involve the repair and reconstruction of sanitary sewers at locations noted during sewer televising; the complete removal and replacement of the existing street pavement, grading of swales and replacement of storm sewer culverts as needed. All turfed areas disturbed by construction will be restored. Existing residential driveway approaches will be restored.

Roads will remain open while the point repairs to sanitary sewers are being made. Detour signs and road closure signs will be posted as construction proceeds to the roadways portion of the project. Residents will not be allowed to park in the street right of way. During most phases of construction, traffic will be able to use the streets and motorists will have access to their property however there may be certain circumstances where some residents may not have access to their property for a limited period of time. In no case will a resident be allowed to park in the street. All attempts will be made to limit the duration of any situation where driveway access is closed. The Contractor will be required to give advance notice to residents of any driveway closure that affects them for an extended period of time.

During street construction mail boxes will be removed from property frontage and ganged together at locations still to be determined. The Village is working with the U.S. Postal Service to determine the best accessible location. You will be notified prior to mail boxes being relocated.

Hoefflerle-Butler Engineering will be providing engineering oversight to this project. If you should have any questions or complaints concerning construction, please call Steve Leiber, the project engineer, during HBE's regular office hours, Mondays through Fridays, 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
