

## NOTICE FOR BIDS

The Village of Justice, Illinois will receive sealed proposals for the following improvements.

### I. Time and Place of Opening Bids:

Sealed Proposals for the improvement described herein will be received at the office of the Village Clerk of Justice, 7800 S. Archer Road, Justice, Illinois, until 10:00 A.M. CDT, Monday, June 18, 2018 and publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

### II. Description of Work:

The proposed work is officially known as

#### **VILLAGE OF JUSTICE 2018 SANITARY SEWER LINING/POINT REPAIRS**

and is further described as follows: All material, labor, equipment and incidentals necessary for 5 Point Repairs to the sanitary sewer, and 470 lineal feet of Cured-in-Place Pipe lining for an 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer and all other related items.

### III. Instructions to Bidders:

- A. Plans and proposal forms may be obtained at the office of the Village Engineer, **HOEFFERLE-BUTLER ENGINEERING, INC.**, 8714 South Roberts Road, Hickory Hills, IL. 60457 for a non-refundable fee of \$ 35.00 per set.
- B. All work will be in conformance with the latest editions of the STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR WATER AND SEWER MAIN CONSTRUCTION IN ILLINOIS and the STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, and all revisions thereto and the specifications contained herein.
- C. Only bidders qualified by previous experience will be entitled to receive plans and submit proposals. Proposals must be labeled clearly on the outside of the bid envelope defining the Cured-in-Place liner's manufacturer, installer and product being proposed.
- D. All proposals must be accompanied by a bank cashier's check, or bank draft, certified check or bid bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

**IV. Applicable Federal/State Requirements:**

- A. All laborers and mechanics employed by Contractor or Subcontractor on construction work for this project shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of April 2018 and all revisions thereto.
- B. All contracts and subcontracts for construction or repair shall include a provision for compliance with the Copeland "Anti-Kickback Act" (18 U.S.C. 874) as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR, Part 3).
- C. Contracts shall include a provision for compliance with Sections 103 and 107 of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. 327-330) as supplemented by Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR, Part 5).
- D. If at the time this contract is executed, or if during the term of this contract, there is excessive unemployment in Illinois as defined in the employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, 30 ILCS 570-0.01 et seq., as two consecutive months of unemployment exceeding 5%, the Contractor agrees to employ Illinois laborers. An "Illinois laborer" is defined as any person who has resided in Illinois for at least thirty (30) days and intends to become or remain an Illinois resident.

**V. Certification:**

The undersigned Bidder does hereby certify that it is not barred from bidding on the contract as a result of a violation of either section 33 E-3 or 33 E-4 of Chapter 38 Illinois revised statutes.

**VI. Rejection of Bids:**

The Village of Justice reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technicalities.
