# General Information

## Administration/Office: 708-458-2520

### Mayor, Village Clerk, & Finance Office:

Services include the sale of Animal Licenses; Collection of Sewer & Refuse Bills; Garage Sale Permits; Notary Services; Passport Services; Sale of Postage Stamps; Vehicle Stickers; Yard Waste and Garbage Matters.

**Sewer and Refuse Billing:** Bills are computed every two months (odd months). Pay your bill in person, by mail, online or use the phone payment system. After hours, use the drop box outside the main office. All major credit cards are accepted.

**Senior Discounts:** Discounted rates on Sewer & Refuse bills and Village Vehicle Stickers are available at age 62 and over. To apply please contact the Finance Office.

### **Village Vehicle Stickers are required!**

In compliance with Village Code Chap. 6, Art. II, Sec. 6-22, all motor vehicles are required to display a municipal vehicle sticker within thirty (30) days of moving into the village or obtaining a vehicle. Annually, vehicle stickers are sold in May and June. Vehicle registration is required to purchase. After June 30th, vehicle sticker applications must be accompanied by a home purchase agreement/signed lease or bill of sale for the vehicle, in order to purchase the sticker at the regular rate.

### **Pet Registration**

In compliance with Village Code Chap. 7, Div., 2, Sec. 7-121, annual registration is required for all cats and dogs in the village. Proof of rabies vaccination must be presented.

**Passport Applications** are available in the Finance Office. Passport services are available Monday-Friday from 8:30AM to 3:00PM.

### **Prescription Drug Take Back Program**

For pharmaceutical take-back materials only.  
No liquid pharmaceutical drugs.  
No loose pharmaceuticals.

### **Building Department: 708-458-2130**

Building code violations; building permits; business and/or multifamily licenses; parking permits; and sale inspections.

### **Public Works Department: 708-458-2961**

Branch chipping; potholes; snowplowing; street repairs; streetlight outages, sewer backups, and any other maintenance related matters.

### **Police Department: 708-458-2191**

*\*Sec. 10-28 (e). Parking: The operator of a vehicle shall not park such vehicle on any street, highway, alley, public way or parkway between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. except Sundays and holidays.*

*\*Sec. 10-28 (c). Parking: Regardless of such posting, no parking shall be allowed on any public street or property within twenty four (24) hours after a snowfall of one inch (1") or more has occurred.*
